Trinity members accomplished much with a "mustard seed" of faith during our Stewardship campaign!

Donations were received and 503 personal care kits assembled to be distributed to those in need by Lutheran World Services.

Seventeen volunteers then volunteered at the New Windsor, MD center packing care kits, folding quilts and cleaning the warehouse.

At the Celebration of Gifts and Blessings event on October 1 Trinity's committees presented entertaining, educational and enlightening displays of activities and opportunities available to all members.

We learned from Bishop Kusserow and our missionaries how our financial support helps spread God's word around the world. Prayer cards were also sent to our missionaries thanking them for their faithful service and work.

During the services and Sunday School we learned how our faith is deepened by being involved in the ministries of the church and using our gifts of time, talents and treasure in God's service.

Finally, we have received 126 commitments totaling \$321,413 to support Trinity's ongoing ministries and missions in 2017. Thank you to all who have already returned their cards!

Trinity—North Side, Pittsburgh Christmas Gifts ~ *Reaching Out in Love*

We will have *twenty* children's "wish-lists" from Trinity North Side church available the **second week of November**. There will be a sign-out sheet available in the front narthex after services and in the church office during the week. This is a ministry of Trinity Lutheran Church, North Side, that we help to support each year.

Trinity North Side is a small Lutheran congregation with a large ministry when it comes to ministering and providing for children (over 600) in this inner city neighborhood in Pittsburgh.

Our members in the past have spent an average of \$100 on each child. If you would like to buy for one of these children but feel that's more than you would like to spend, maybe you could go in with another family or two ... or with friends or co-workers. We do have members that volunteer their time to shop if you would rather donate money. Any amount would be appreciated.
